Please avoid the cute plastic-coated ones- they are cute, but they don't always sharpen well, the tips break, and the plastic coating messes with the pencil sharpeners.

I know that it takes sacrifice to afford school supplies. These supplies, along with the supplies students are given at school, help with their education; and we all know how important a good education is.
